

T bar hoist

Before use:

- Persons using this machine must be a licensed or competent experienced operator.
- Read the hazard assessment sheet.
- Ensure area is suitable for machine operation and no bystanders are present.
- Ensure the working area is clear of obstructions, powerlines and all other hazards.

OPERATING PROCEDURE

Do not operate unless:

You learn and practice the principles of safe machine operation and read the hazard assesment sheet.

1. Avoid hazardous situations.
2. Always perform a pre-operation inspection looking for damage or faults including:
 - Cable anchor
 - Cable and pulleys
 - Masts
 - Nuts and bolts
 - Load lifting platform and locking pin
 - Correct operation of winch
 - Legs their locking devices
 - Casters and brakes
 - Cracks in welds
3. Always perform function tests prior to use.
4. Inspect the workplace.
5. Only use the machine as it was intended.

SETUP

Select an area that is firm, level and free of obstructions.

OPERATION OF HOIST

Select an area that is firm, level and free of obstructions.

1. Lock brakes on casters.
2. Do not operate hoist in high wind areas.
3. Position goods in the centre of the platform.
4. Keep hair, clothing, and etc clear of winch mechanism.
5. Keep personnel clear of hoist when lifting.
6. Do not use hoist as scaffold or lean ladders against it.
7. Stand clear of hoist when lowering
