(Guide only)

CHARGING THE BATTERY

- 1. Connect the adaptor to a power supply.
- 2. Connect the plug to the port of the control box.
- Turn the switch knob to 'CHARGE' position.
- 4. The indicator will change from red to green when finished charging.

CONNECTION

- 1. Open the suitcase and spread the sunshade.
- 2. Connect one end to the control box.
- 3. Release the break until the unit spins freely.
- 4. Put the wire into the wire hook.
- 5. Connect the camera to the coil.

WARNING: Check the waterproof ring between all connections.



STARTING UP

- 1. Insert SD card (if you have one please note this is **NOT** supplied by Hiredepot.)
- 2. Plug in microphone.
- 3. Turn the knob to the 'ON/BATT' position.
- 4. Record video (if using SD card).
- 5. If using SD card, take photo and playback using the video camera button. Long press button to playback.
- 6. Support to record audio by microphone and input text by keyboard when recording video.
- 7. Press 'RESET' button to reset the counter if needed. Press 'RECORDING DIRECTORY' to switch metre / feet.
- 8. Press the zoom in / out buttons as required when recording. When playing a video, you can use these two buttons to adjust the volume.

- 9. To adjust the volume, use the buttons pictured opposite. When playing a video, press these two buttons to fast forward / rewind.

- 10. Use the LED BRIGHT button to adjust the light of the camera. (min / max).
- 11. To play the video, press the buttons pictured adjacent.





12. To delete the video, press the two buttons below.

- Pay attention to the direction of the SD card (if using one).
- Do not use USB stick and SD card at the same time.
- Do not insert or remove the U disk or SD card during the photo / video process.
